A NEW consortium has come to the aid of the cash-strapped Australian company which developed the world's first retractable syringe. Melbourne-based Uniject Australia developed the syringe, which prevents needlestick injuries, in 1994 but it went into voluntary administration in 2002. Now a US-Australian consortium has bought Uniject's assets for over \$4 million.
