Help for Uni-ject

A NEWLY formed consortium has come to the aid of the cash strapped Australian company which developed the world's first retractable syringe.

Melbourne-based Uni-ject Australia developed the syringe, which prevents needle stick injuries and reduces the need for dangerous and expensive sharps containers, in 1994.

Uni-ject went into voluntary administration in mid-2002.

A US-Australian consortium, ENSIMED International (Eliminate Needle Stick Injuries and Medical), has now bought Uni-ject's intellectual property and assets for over \$4 million
